

(UUT18) Efficacy and prospects of Digital Healthcare in Ukraine during and post-conflict

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Project Aim

- Investigation of adoption and efficacy of digital health initiatives underway in Ukraine, such as Ukraine TeleHelp, Doctor Online, and Helping Hand. It is important to understand the adoption and efficacy for various reasons:
 - Currently, digital health protocols and delivery of service have been developed by volunteer organizations on an ad-hoc basis.
 - It shall pave the way to recommend appropriate techniques and protocols for quality digital healthcare in Ukraine.

Project Objectives

- Understand the adoption and efficacy of existing formats and initiatives of digital healthcare in Ukraine
- Based on the good practices in digital healthcare in the UK, recommend appropriate protocols for the delivery and synergy of digital healthcare.

1. Journal Publication (International Journal of the Digital Human or Digital Health)
2. Short Report Recommendations for the Ministry of Health
3. News Article
